



## Final Information

The VDE E-Race is approaching fast and there are only a few days left until it kicks off in Schwedt. This document provides you with the latest information and some documents that will be helpful for a smooth event.

### Equipment

We are staying at a regular campsite, which means you will need a CEE adapter to plug in Schuko connectors.

Rather than purchasing cones for an event of this size, we will be relying on yours for the dynamics disciplines. If you plan to run driverless disciplines, it is essential that you bring FSG-compliant cones for the track setup. Please label your cones with your team name and/or number so we can sort everything correctly after the event.

For the electrical technical inspection, we do not have all measuring equipment available on-site. Please make sure to bring a multimeter and insulation tester. These items, along with others, are listed in the separate packing list.

To protect the campsite ground, please bring suitable materials to cover the floor of your pit box — for example, tarpaulins, rubber mats, or similar coverings. This helps preserve the surface and keeps our host happy.

### Communication

Any last-minute changes will be communicated primarily through the WhatsApp group, where you can also get quick answers to questions. To keep information flowing efficiently, each team is welcome to add 1–2 members who are closely involved in event organisation. New members no longer need to be approved — just join.

### Real Case

This year's VDE E-Race will again include a Real Case as part of the Cost and Manufacturing Event. You can find the task description in a separate document on our homepage.

## Detailed Schedule

The full event schedule is available for download on our website and includes your team's statics timeslots. If you want to swap a slot with another team, coordinate with them first and then reach out to us together.

You can also use your timeslot for a Q&A session with the judges — just drop us a short note if that's the plan.
